### WHAT

The Certificate of Bible & Ministry (CB&M) is a training program through the Presbyterian Theological College for those seeking to further their Christian knowledge, such as elders, deacons, Sunday School teachers, youth leaders, Bible study group leaders, Christian teachers. It is also valuable as pre-theological training. It consists of a number of short courses.

**THE CORE SUBJECTS** offered are: Old Testament Survey, New Testament Survey, Church History Survey, Doctrine Survey, Practical Ethics, Bible Books

**MINISTRY SKILLS:** Preparing Bible Talks, Eldership Training, Diaconal Training, Biblical Counselling, Evangelism and witness training, Cross-cultural ministry training

### COURSE REQUIREMENTS

**Foundation Level:** 8 subjects (must include at least 4 core subjects)

**2nd Class Honours:** 10 subjects (must include at least 5 core subjects)

**1st Class Honours:** 12 subjects (must include at least 6 core subjects)

### ASSESSMENT

Subjects can be taken either by audit or for assessment. Assignments adding up to 1000 words per subject will be set by lecturers. This may consist of a 1000 word paper, or 2 x 500 words; or book reviews may be included. There will be a choice of topics offered to the student.

Those who fulfill the requirements for the CB&M will receive the certificate at the graduation service in November.

### WHERE

Classes will be conducted at the Presbyterian Theological College. Each subject will be held weekly for 6 weeks, 2 hours per night or by intensive mode of two Saturdays, six hours each.

### COST

\$66 for each subject per individual or married couple covers tuition, marking and materials.

A number of short courses are now available for study by those in country Victoria and interstate, with more subjects to be offered in the near future.

The cost for the short courses by distance is as follows:

Enrolment fee for one subject \$40 per person or couple (for those taking the subject for assessment as part of CB&M)

Cost of CD \$22.50 (including \$2.50 postage and handling)

Cost of 6 DVD set \$95 (includes \$5 postage and handling)

Hire of DVD for two months \$40 (plus cost of return mail)

Total cost per subject on CD \$62.50

Total cost per subject on 6 DVD set \$135

The short courses are taught at the College by qualified lecturers
